The Bridge is a community youth center that is supported by over 100 area businesses, 15 area churches, over 350 individuals along with grants and foundations

Depending on the program we are running, we work with between 35-80 kids per day doing the school year and 25-35 kids each day in the summer

We are reliant on over 50 volunteers to work with kids throughout our school year programming and will need up to 5-6 on Wednesday's in the summer.

We feed kids meals during every program and are reliant on our community to help with this. We don't want anyone to go home hungry.

Our vision is to build relationships, so that we can gain trust and make differences. By engaging students with caring community members both inside and outside of our walls, students recognize there is an entire community that loves and cares for them.
